Personal Work Experience: BSc degree in Psychology with an emphasis in psychopharmacology/behavioural pharmacology and statistics; self-taught SQL programming; 4 years' work experience as a data analyst/manager; 3 years' experience as a consultant with IMS Health; currently pursuing MSc in Medical Statistics (part-time) sponsored by IMS Health.

Average day in the job: Every day is a little different, which adds variety and new/different challenges, with meetings sprinkled throughout the day with the project team (other statisticians, epidemiologists, programmers, project managers, medical directors and strategists) to review the previous day's/week's progress and to plan for the next week's agenda/strategies/risks. Then depending on the project phase, some deep work writing a proposal, programming specifications, or statistical analysis plan along with researching to gain deeper knowledge on the therapy area for the project we are working on or getting lost in programming in SQL or SAS.

General pieces of advice: Remember the reasons why you pursued global health and don't get caught up in office politics. We are all here based on some desire to improve the quality of life.

An understanding of the pharmaceutical industry is an advantage, as it allows you to engage with clients which is a highly-desired skill on top of one's academic training (MSc or PhD).
