



- You may be given a case study at the interview and have to consider it there and then

"The case study will feature a business problem that you will seek to solve during the interview. It will not require extensive knowledge of specific industries or processes and some cases have no right or wrong answers. Your questions and thought processes are more important than coming up with an actual solution." (BCG)



- Highlight skills (more than content of previous research, unless specifically relevant)
- Consider impression does it look as though you would prefer academia?
- 2 page CV (or 1 page)
- Match to person specification/description of who they look for
