My motivation to pursue a career at this firm stems from its recent collaboration with Canadian Blood Services. EY's innovative strategy of improving the traceability of blood products using blockchain resonates deeply with my passion for developing creative solutions within the Canadian healthcare landscape. My interest was further reinforced through conversations with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in the Toronto office. Their insights into the firm's commitment to excellence have affirmed that EY will support my growth-oriented mindset and foster my development into a forward-thinking consultant.

I am confident that I have amassed the necessary skills to effectively contribute to the EY Health Consulting team. First, my completion of the Master of Science in Public Health (MScPH) at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (LSHTM) has sharpened my written, interpersonal and verbal communication skills. For example, I effectively synthesised evidence from 14 studies to produce a 10,000-word dissertation on interventions to improve antiretroviral therapy adherence in Sub-Saharan Africa. Furthermore, I collaborated with 4 researchers to build a statistical model that assessed the risk factors for neonatal mortality in Tuvalu, which we then presented to 50 peers and educators at an LSHTM Research Day.

Second, my experience as a Research Analyst at University Health Network has honed my project management skills. In this role, I led a team of 4 writers to synthesise 194 scientific sources and produce a high-quality 6000-word manuscript within the deadlines established by external editors. This manuscript was ultimately accepted by the prestigious journal *Transplantation* and has been cited by 14 studies at the time of writing.

Third, my 20-hour work weeks in the hospitality industry while completing my degree at University of Toronto developed my organisational and time management skills. During this period, I produced excellent deliverables while under time pressure, as made evident by the fact that I graduated in the top 5% of my class.
