Check your CV and Cover Letter with CareerSet

CareerSet enables you to check, score, and improve your CV and Cover Letter using their Al-powered platform. You can 'Score my CV' to receive actionable feedback on your CV; 'Target my CV' to tailor your CV to a specific role; and 'Review my cover letter' to optimise and personalise your cover letter. For 2025, CareerSet have introduced enhanced cover letter feedback, including functionality that generates live grammar and spelling suggestions, and an Al rewrite functionality.
