### **Check your CV and Cover Letter with CareerSet**

CareerSet enables you to check, score, and improve your CV and Cover Letter using their Alpowered platform. You can 'Score my CV' to receive actionable feedback on your CV; 'Target my CV' to tailor your CV to a specific role; and 'Review my cover letter' to optimise and personalise your cover letter. For 2025, CareerSet have introduced enhanced cover letter feedback, including functionality that generates live grammar and spelling suggestions, and an Al rewrite functionality.

This link logs you in for one session, and your account is created upon your first login, where you can read and accept the terms and privacy policy.

You also have access as a graduate - you can sign up to CareerSet with your personal or alumni email address by clicking on the 'alumni sign up' and entering the code **LSHTMGRAD**.

eCareersGrad is a fantastic resource to help you prepare for interviews and commercial case studies (used by management consultancies), as well as providing you with information on who hires and sponsors international grads in the UK.
