# **Michelson Prizes – Now Accepting Applications**

The \$150,000 research grants are awarded annually by <u>Michelson Medical Research</u> <u>Foundation</u> and the <u>Human Immunome Project</u> to early-career scientists advancing human immunology, vaccine discovery, and immunotherapy for major global diseases. Eligibility: They are seeking applicants 35 and under who are deepening our understanding of human immunology and uncovering new approaches to combating diseases. All early-career investigators, post-docs, clinical fellows—including residents and interns—and other researchers in training are eligible to apply. International applicants are encouraged. <u>Apply here</u>.
