Check your CV and Cover Letter with CareerSet

CareerSet enables you to check, score, and improve your CV and Cover Letter using their AI-powered platform. You can 'Score my CV' to receive actionable feedback on your CV; 'Target my CV' to tailor your CV to a specific role; and 'Review my cover letter' to optimise and personalise your cover letter. **You can access and use the platform via this link: <https://careerset.com/lshtm>** This link logs you in for one session, and your account is created upon your first login, where you can read and accept the terms and privacy policy. Novo Nordisk Graduate Programme

The Novo Nordisk Graduate Programme is a 2-year, global career programme with a minimum of three rotations including at least one rotation outside your home country. The destination depends on the specific graduate programme track but it could for instance be in the Novo Nordisk Headquarters office in Copenhagen, Denmark, the International Operations (IO) Strategic Head Office in Zurich, an IO Regional Office or one of their many affiliates. Applications open on 1st November and close on 30 November 2024 for graduate positions starting in September 2025.
