Check your CV and Cover Letter with CareerSet

CareerSet enables you to check, score, and improve your CV and Cover Letter using their AI-powered platform. You can 'Score my CV' to receive actionable feedback on your CV; 'Target my CV' to tailor your CV to a specific role; and 'Review my cover letter' to optimise and personalise your cover letter. **You can access and use the platform via this link:** <u>https://careerset.com/lshtm</u> This link logs you in for one session, and your account is created upon your first login, where you can read and accept the terms and privacy policy.
