Working in the UK: Visa Options, Fri 16 Feb, 13.00-14.00 (UK time)

If you are a non-UK national and have questions about visa options, do come along to our online visa talk on Friday 16 February. This session is about the two main **work visa options** for those graduating: the **Skilled Worker route** (formerly Tier 2) for work sponsored by an employer, and the 2-year Graduate route. We have invited Andrew Humphrey, an external adviser and trainer, to cover this topic as the Careers team do not give advice about visas. Andrew will cover the basics of the Skilled Worker route and he will explain what you need to know. We have also asked him to talk about best
